Real Local Cases. Real Community Impact.

Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR) technology gives law enforcement another tool to locate vehicles connected to serious crimes, identify suspects, recover stolen property, and protect vulnerable members of the community. The cases below are examples of local investigations in which ALPR information assisted officers and investigators.

- 01** **Murder Suspect Located in Stolen Vehicle**
A Flock alert on a stolen vehicle from Pennsylvania led to a traffic stop. The driver was found to be wanted for murder in Oregon.
July 2022
- 02** **\$3.5 Million Multi-State Jewelry Burglary Ring**
Flock information aided investigators in locating suspects tied to a jewelry burglary ring involving 18 incidents across 11 states and more than \$3.5 million in reported losses.
May 2024
- 03** **Attempted Child Kidnapping Investigation**
ALPR technology aided investigators in locating a subject after an attempted child kidnapping at a local middle school.
September 2025
- 04** **Gang-Related Shooting Suspects Located**
Flock aided in locating and apprehending individuals involved in a gang-related shooting in Warsaw.
July 2025
- 05** **Downtown Warsaw Shooting Suspects Apprehended**
Flock aided in locating and apprehending suspects involved in a shooting in downtown Warsaw.
June 2026
- 06** **\$40,000 in Crosswalk Sign Damage Identified**
In two separate incidents involving semis striking crosswalk signs valued at \$20,000 each, Flock information helped identify the vehicles involved.
